This marvel of engineering, built in the 1st century AD, stands as a testament to Roman ingenuity, featuring arches that once carried water from the Francolí River to supply the city of Tarraco.*

It is home to many of Valencia's most iconic landmarks, such as the Cathedral of Valencia and the Plaza de la Virgen. The winding streets and narrow alleys of the Old Town are lined with medieval buildings, colorful squares, and bustling cafes, making it a favorite spot for locals and tourists alike. One of the highlights of Valencia's Old Town is the Central Market, a bustling indoor market that has been in operation for over a century.  - *Malvarrosa Beach in Valencia is a wide, golden-sand urban beach lined with palm trees, lively cafés, and seafood restaurants serving the city's famous paella. Popular with both locals and tourists, it offers a relaxed Mediterranean vibe with plenty of space for sunbathing, walking, and water sports.*
-  Traditional Paella lunch including a performance by Flamenco Artists.
 - *Paella is a traditional Spanish rice dish that originated in the Valencia region and has become one of Spain's most iconic meals. It is typically cooked in a wide, shallow pan over an open flame, using short-grain rice infused with saffron for its golden color and rich flavor.*
 - *This Andalusian art integrates singing, dancing and music, mainly from the sound of the guitar. The different flamenco styles, known as 'palos', are characterized by great emotional intensity, both in the lyrics of the songs and in the performance of the artists, be they singers, dancers or guitarists.*

 - *Llíria, located in the Valencia region of Spain, is known as the “**City of Music**” for its rich band and orchestral traditions. The town boasts Roman and Moorish heritage, with highlights like the **San Miguel Monastery**, Arab baths, and ancient Roman mosaics. Surrounded by scenic countryside and vineyards, Llíria combines cultural history with a vibrant musical scene and local festivals.*

Visitors can explore intimate rooms, listen to Casals' music, and learn about his profound influence on 20th-century classical music.*

L'Auditori is a modern concert hall that was built to complement the city's musical landscape, offering additional venues and spaces for diverse musical performances and events alongside the historic Palau de la Música. The design of the hall was constructed with the aim of emulating the acoustics of the three most famous concert halls in the world: the Amsterdam Concertgebouw, Boston Symphony Hall and the Vienna Große Musikvereinssaal (Golden Hall). It is the home of Barcelona City & Catalanian National Orchestras.
